

GUIDELINES TO AUTHORS

- **1.** JOURNAL OF INDIAN VETERINARY ASSOCIATION (JIVA) publishes papers of original work as full length Research papers, Review articles, Clinical articles and Short communications from all fields of Veterinary and Animal Sciences.
- 2. Papers shall be accepted by the editorial committee for publication based on the facts mentioned below and on the concrete understanding that
- **a.** The paper submitted has not been published before and also it is not being considered for publication elsewhere. All authors should sign a certificate to this effect in respect of each article. Names, qualifications, full addresses and email ID of all authors is mandatory. Details of the corresponding author and address of the institution/place where research work has been undertaken must be clearly specified.
- **b.** All authors are jointly responsible for the contents published in the article.
- **c.** The Editorial Committee under no circumstances shall be responsible for the contents published in the article.
- 3. For publishing in the journal, article may be submitted by email only to editorjiva@yahoo.com.
- 4. Article may be sent typewritten in MS Word, Times New Roman, font size 12 pt, and
 1.5 line spacing in A4 size paper (strictly adhere to the standard font and format mentioned here).
- a. Research Article, Clinical article and short communications may be in the following format
- b. Title Title of the article should be clear and concise.
- c. Author(s) Designation/Affiliation with full address and pin code
- d. Full papers-Abstract (not more than 100 words), Keywords (not more than 4 words), Introduction, Materials and methods, Results& Discussions, Summary, Acknowledgment and References. The full papers should not exceed 5 printed pages. Word limit for Research and Review Article is 2000 words, including tables, graphs etc.



- e. **Clinical articles-** Abstract (not more than 100 words), Keywords (not more than 4 words), Introduction, Case history and Observation, Treatment & Discussions, Summary, Acknowledgment and References. The full papers should not exceed 4 printed pages.
- f. Short Communications- Abstract (not more than 100 words), Keywords (not more than 4 words), Introduction, Materials and methods, Results & Discussions, Acknowledgment, References. Short communications should not exceed 2 printed pages.
- g. **Tables, photographs, graphs etc.** should bear the reference number (table 1, table 2 etc) and the title.
- h. Page limit is inclusive of figures, photographs and tables.
- References should be arranged in alphabetical order and numbered. Reference should be given in the format; Name of the author (s), followed by year, Title, Name of the Journal, Volume, Issue and Page Number.

- **5.** Processing and publication fees (For authors inside India)
 - Initial processing fees: Rs 100/-
 - Payment of processing fee doesn't ensure publication of article

Publication Fees: After acceptance of article

- For Research and Review article: Rs 200/- per author
- Clinical article/Short communication: Rs 100/-Per author
- Non Members of Indian Veterinary Association, Kerala-Should remit an additional amount of Rs 500/- for each author
- 6. Processing and publication fees (For authors outside India)-After acceptance of article
 - International Cheques/DD for the amount equivalent to Rs 2500/-
- **7.** Each article will be given a reference number. In all correspondence authors should mention the reference number.
- **8.** The decision of Editorial Committee is final in all matters pertaining to publication of article.
